Upon registration, you have agreed to the following MWFHA Player Code of Conduct.

- I will play hockey because I want to, not because others or coaches want me to
 - I will play by the rules of hockey, and in the spirit of the game
 - I will control my temper – fighting and “mouthing off” can spoil the activity for everybody
 - I will respect my opponents
 - I will remember that winning isn’t everything – that having fun, improving skills, making friends and doing my best are also important
 - I will acknowledge all good plays/performances – those of my team and of my opponents
 - I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me. I will accept their decisions and show them respect.
 - I will co-operate with my coach, teammates, officials and opponents.
 - I will respect the facilities and the rink staff
 - I will not conduct myself in a disrespectful manner. Disrespectful is defined as action or words deemed rude, unpleasant, inappropriate, or unprofessional and found to be offensive to others
 - I will do my best to be a true team player by treating my teammates, coaches, officials, and opponents with respect, encouraging and supporting others, and working together toward our shared goals. I will help build my teammates up, on and off the ice, and contribute to a positive, inclusive team environment. I will come to practices and games prepared to work hard, be coachable, and contribute positively to my team
 - I will cooperate and not obstruct MWFHA should an incident take place and the Path to Redemption Policy be utilized. This will be for the betterment of the Association, its players and the spirit of the game
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
